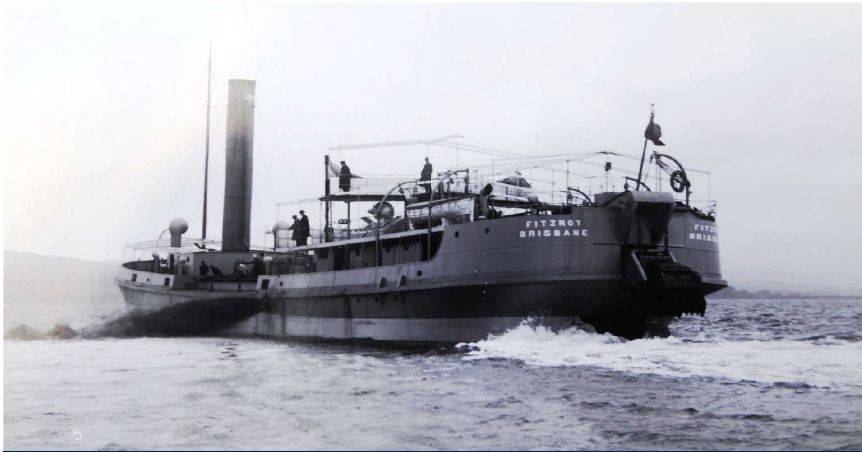

Above: TRAILING SUCTION HOPPER DREDGER FITZROY

Built by Fleming & Ferguson in Paisley, U.K. in 1925 for the Port of Brisbane Authority.
IMO 5115680 Twin screw. GT 766 DWT 914 loa: 62.3 m. beam: 11 m.
The dredger was broken up in Bundaberg March 1980.

Over the years and lately for the Brisbane Airport as well as Fisherman's island extensive dredging was undertaken.

During the period **1989-2000** NQEA in Cairns built following 3 dredgers for the Port of Brisbane Corporation although initially ordered/owned by Queensland Cement. Cutter Suction Dredger **AMITY** in 1990, (info in this newsletter)
